



GSA Bill #14

A bill supporting the “What Now: Know Your Rights & Responsibilities” forum

1           **WHEREAS**, current efforts are ongoing to alleviate students, faculty, staff and community  
2 members of underrepresented minority groups of the fear of unknown future changes in rights,  
3 laws and policies, and

4           **WHEREAS**, the Office of Academic Success and Intercultural Services (OASIS) and the  
5 LGBTQA+ Resource Center will organize a forum with Nebraska State Senators and ACLU  
6 lawyers speaking about expected changes in policies and understanding rights, responsibilities and  
7 actions students, and

8           **WHEREAS**, the Graduate Student Assembly (GSA) Committee for Diversity and  
9 Inclusion shall encourage and promote participation by students from throughout the University  
10 community, including, but not limited to, students from racial and ethnic minorities, international  
11 students, women, the LGBTQA+ community, and distance learning students, and ensure that GSA  
12 programming is available and pertinent to the diverse graduate student community.

13           **THEREFORE, LET IT BE ENACTED**, that the GSA will support and advertise the  
14 “What Now: Know Your Rights & Responsibilities” forum, and

15           **THEREFORE, LET IT BE FINALLY ENACTED**, that the GSA will co-sponsor the  
16 event with LGBTQA+ Resource Center to apply for non-GSA funding.
