

GSA Bill #28 Sexual Assault Awareness Month Advocacy Event, HuskerOut 3.0

- WHEREAS, per the passage of Bills 12 and 18, the Graduate Student Assembly (GSA) has successfully lobbied legislation pertinent to graduate and professional students,
- WHEREAS, bills LB857 Adopt the Campus Confidentiality Act, LB988 Adopt an affirmative consent standard with respect to sexual assault, and LB1126 Adopt the Sexual Assault Survivors' Bill of Rights Act, were introduced to the Nebraska Unicameral Legislature, and their enactment would significantly improve the reporting process for survivors of sexual assault and harassment,
- **WHEREAS**, graduate and professional students are a particularly vulnerable demographic to sexual harassment and assault,
- WHEREAS, Sexual Assault Awareness month is observed every year in April, under the coordination of the National Sexual Violence Resource Center,
- **WHEREAS**, as per our organizational mission and the established precedent, the GSA can reach out to faculty, staff, students, recognized student organizations, administrators, and others to inform them of how they can advocate to improve the conditions in which graduate and professional students contribute to the University,
- WHEREAS the GSA Committee for Diversity and Inclusion is committed to support students from throughout the University community and to ensure that GSA programming is available and pertinent to the diverse graduate student community,
- THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED, that the GSA, in collaboration with volunteers from ASUN and other graduate students, will hold a series of #HuskerOut 3.0 events between the 3rd and the 18th of April. The focus of these events would be to educate attendees about the proposed legislation, offer a chance to write to legislators and university administrators regarding student issues, and express support to survivors of sexual assault and harassment via a collaborative art project. Additionally, representatives from the GSA Diversity and Inclusion Committee will also represent the GSA at the End Rape on Campus March that will be held on April 5, 2018,
- **THEREFORE, LET IT BE FINALLY ENACTED,** that the GSA authorizes the Committee for Diversity and Inclusion to allocate up to \$200.00 from account 408 (Diversity and Inclusion Committee) for the purposes of securing art supplies, cleaning supplies, and promotional material, and to secure GSA representation at the End Rape on Campus March.
