



GSA Bill #17

A bill expressing support for those affected by flooding in Nebraska

1 WHEREAS, in March 2019, widespread flooding occurred in Nebraska along the Missouri and  
2 Platte rivers, leaving many without homes and causing road closures and other difficulties; and,

4 WHEREAS, recently, in response to the flooding of the city’s wellheads, Lincoln issued a  
5 mandatory 50% water use reduction, which also affected the University campuses and the  
6 students present during the reduction mandate, as well as residents of Lincoln at large; and,

8 WHEREAS, the University of Nebraska – Lincoln has posted information about the flooding and  
9 ways in which UNL students and faculty can help;

11 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Graduate Student Assembly (GSA) expresses its  
12 gratitude and support of the recovery efforts taken by local authorities in response to this event;

15 THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that GSA will post information detailing ways  
16 that students can help, express its support through social media, and will encourage graduate  
17 students of the University to make donations to the recovery process.
