A bill authorizing the organization of a Graduate Students Welcome Social

1 **WHEREAS**, the Graduate Student Assembly (GSA) Committee for Social Events, in
2 line with their commitment to support students from throughout the University community
3 including, but not limited to, students from racial and ethnic minorities, international students,
4 women, the LGBTQA+ community, and distance learning students, and to ensure that GSA
5 programming is available and pertinent to the diverse graduate student community,

7 **WHEREAS**, a welcome social event at the beginning of the semester with collaboration
8 with International Student and Scholar Office (ISSO) can enhance the campus experience for
9 new graduate students and foster connections between international students and domestic
10 students.

12 **THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED**, that the GSA authorizes Committee for Social
13 Events to organize a Graduate Students Welcome Social event on the month of January 2020. In
14 this event, students of the University of Nebraska – Lincoln will have an opportunity to connect
15 with peers and learn about different cultures.

17 **THEREFORE, BE IT FINALLY ENACTED**, that the GSA allocates up to \$1,000.00
18 from account 402 (Social and Networking Events) for food catering in support of the event.
