A bill authorizing GSA co-sponsorship of OGS trick-or-treat event.

1 **WHEREAS**, GSA supports and represents a diverse population of graduate and
2 professional students, some of whom have children.

3 **WHEREAS**, the Office of Graduate Studies (OGS) is putting on a trick-or-treat event for
4 the children of graduate and professional students on either October 29th and 31st from
5 3:00-4:30pm in the OGS. A variety of trick or treat items including peanut free, vegan,
6 gluten-free, etc. will be provided. Decorations will be appropriate for all ages. Many
7 OGS staff will be in costumes. Children are encouraged to wear their costumes also and
8 snacks and drinks will be available; and,

10 **WHEREAS**, OGS has requested that GSA be willing to co-sponsor this event in order to
11 help spread information about it and help connect this event with graduate and
12 professional students with children that might be interested in attending; and,

14 **WHEREAS**, OGS has requested that GSA provide 4-5 volunteers on either October 29th
15 and 31st from 2:30-5:00 PM to run a table with candy; and,

17 **THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED**, that the GSA will co-sponsor this event by
18 advertising through our channels and encouraging those who wish to attend with their
19 children to do so.

21 **THEREFORE, BE IT FINALLY ENACTED**, that the GSA will provide 4-5
22 volunteers and allot up to \$100 from Networking and Special Events to purchase candy
23 for a table at the event.
